

Eligibility Requirements:

- At least 55 years of age
- A resident of Onondaga County
- Assessed to be eligible for nursing facility level of care

Additionally you must meet the following Conditions of Enrollment:

- Determined to be capable of safely residing in the community with PACE CNY support services at time of enrollment
- Qualify for Medicaid and/or Medicare or agree to pay the private pay amounts set forth in the Enrollment Agreement
- In need of the long-term care services of the plan for more than 120 days



Payment/Insurance Coverage:

- Fees are completely covered for individuals eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid Benefits.
- Those ineligible for Medicaid and Medicare or eligible for Medicare only are responsible for a monthly fee, payable through private payment.
- PACE participants may be liable for the costs of services not authorized through the PACE program (other than emergency services).

The PACE CNY purpose is to provide a comprehensive benefit package to individuals who require support to stay at home. The PACE CNY interdisciplinary team is comprised of primary care physicians and nurses; physical, occupational, and speech therapists; recreation therapists; social workers; home health aides; dietitians; drivers, and other specialists, as needed, depending on what your loved one requires. Services from these individuals may be provided in the participant's home, day health centers, or long-term care facilities, if needed. On-call health care coverage by doctors and nurses is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
